PROJECT LOCATION: Council District 2 and 4

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION:**

This Project will convert existing high voltage series street lighting system to a low voltage lighting system along Riverside Drive from Lankershim Boulevard to Camarillo Street, and along Vineland Avenue from Hortense St. to Riverside Dr., replacing existing poles, conduit wires, foundations, pullboxes, and luminaires. Work includes installation of 62 modern street lighting poles, foundations, conduit, wires, 76 LED luminaires and 40 LED soffit units. The project will also include the installation of 76 remote monitoring node units to provide real-time reporting of light outages/failures.

Financing for this project is front funded by SB1 (Senate Bill 1 for Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Act – Local Streets and Roads Program).

The project will not result in an increase to existing Street Lighting Maintenance Assessments and therefore Prop 218 assessment ballot proceeding is not required.
