BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

This project will convert the existing series street lighting systems to low voltage by replacing 422 fixtures/lamps with LED fixtures/lamps (314 cobraheads and 108 retrofit kits/lamps). Work also includes the installation of new conduit, pullboxes and wires. In addition, the project will include the installation of technology to provide real-time reporting of light outages/failures. The project area is located in the areas of Downtown, Boyle Heights, Palms, Westlake, No Ho Arts District, North Hills, Sun Valley, Chatsworth and Sherman Oaks.

Financing for this project is front-funded by two funding sources: a loan from the Public Works Trust Fund (PWTF), and a loan from the Municipal Improvement Corporation of Los Angeles (MICLA). The project cost will be later reimbursed by the Federal Highway Administration.

This project will not result in an increase to existing Street Lighting Maintenance Assessments. A Proposition 218 ballot proceeding is not required.
