BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

This project will install security lighting at 21 bus stops identified from the list provided by the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA) that qualify for federal reimbursement. Work includes installation of 36 new lighting poles, foundations, conduit, wires, 40 LED luminaires, and 2 retrofit upgrades. The improvements at these bus stops will greatly enhance the existing security lighting system's reliability and light output, thereby improving bus riders/pedestrian safety sensibility.

Financing for this project is initially from the Public Works Trust Fund, and later reimbursed by the LACMTA-FTA (Federal Transit Authority).

This is a general benefit project and therefore will not result in an increase to existing street lighting maintenance assessments. A Proposition 218 ballot proceeding is not required.

THE CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE CLASSIFICATION REQUIRED FOR AWARD IS **"C-10" or "A"**.
