**BRIEF DESCRIPTION:**

This project will install a new low voltage lighting system with LED luminaires on Lemon Grove Ave. between Serrano Ave. and Western Ave., and on Oxford Ave. between Lemon Grove Ave. and Romaine St. A total of 13 new concrete lighting poles will be installed to meet lighting standards for vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Work includes installation of street lighting poles, foundations, conduit, wires and luminaires. This system will provide additional security for the residents in an area that currently does not have lighting.

Financing for this project is front-funded by the Street Lighting Maintenance Assessment Fund and later reimbursed by Federal Funds under the Transportation, Community, and System Preservation Program.

The lighting district has been established through a Proposition 218 ballot measure. Assessments rates have been verified and will be imposed upon completion of the project..
