BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

This project will replace the existing street lighting series lighting system with a low voltage multiple street lighting system. Work includes installation of 57 new steel fluted street lighting poles with ornamental base, foundations, conduit, wires and LED luminaires. The project will also include the installation of technology to provide real-time reporting of light outages/failures. The project area is primarily along Main St. between 43rd St. and the intersection of Main St./36th Pl./Broadway Pl./36th St.

Financing for this project is front funded from the Special Gas Tax Fund and the Street Lighting Maintenance Assessment Fund, and reimbursed by the Federal Highway Administration.

This project will not result in an increase to existing Street Lighting Maintenance Assessments. A Proposition 218 ballot proceeding is not required.

THE CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE CLASSIFICATION REQUIRED FOR AWARD IS **"C-10" or "A"**.
