**BRIEF DESCRIPTION:**

This project will replace the existing street lighting series lighting system with a low voltage multiple street lighting system. Work includes installation of 76 new steel fluted street lighting poles, foundations, conduit, wires and luminaires. The project will also include the installation of technology to provide real-time reporting of light outages/failures. The project area is primarily along Riverside Dr. between Clybourn Ave. and Lankershim Blvd.

Financing for this project is front funded from the Special Gas Tax Fund and the Street Lighting Maintenance Assessment Fund, and reimbursed by the Federal Highway Administration.

The street lighting maintenance assessments for this project have been confirmed in accordance to the conditions required by Proposition 218.

THE CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE CLASSIFICATION REQUIRED FOR AWARD IS **"C-10" or "A"**.
