

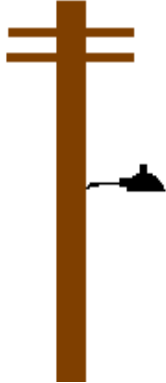

UTILITARIAN LIGHTING SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

Where requested, a new utilitarian light may be installed if the proposed location meets the following criteria:

1. There is an existing wooden utility pole at the requested location. *subject to height requirements
2. There is no other streetlight within 300 feet, or, the location is at an unlighted intersection with a wooden utility pole.
3. The utility pole must not be on private property.
*If the utility pole is on private property please call the Department of Water and Power at 1-800-DIAL-DWP (1-800-342-5397) for information on the Outdoor Area Lighting Program (a separate DWP program).
4. The request is to light a public right-of-way (street, sidewalk or alley).

*Note: A new utilitarian light may require the signatures of the four property owners closest to the proposed new light.

Utilitarian Lighting alternatives:

An alternative to Utilitarian Lighting is Electrolier Lighting, which consists of lights on steel or concrete poles of either a modern or ornamental style. Electrolier Lighting systems are designed to provide consistent and uniform lighting for both the street and sidewalk.

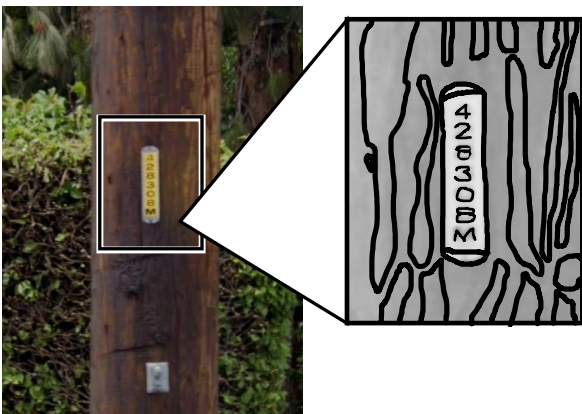



Wooden Pole Identification numbers:

Every wooden utility pole has a metal ID number tag. Some may have two metal ID number tags. Both types are shown below. The ID number tags are fastened to the wooden pole. Below is an example of what to look for.
